Three work phases of the OD Expert Group

1

Develop concrete policy proposals for the revision of the OMP Regulation

Develop an operational framework for modulating incentives & policies

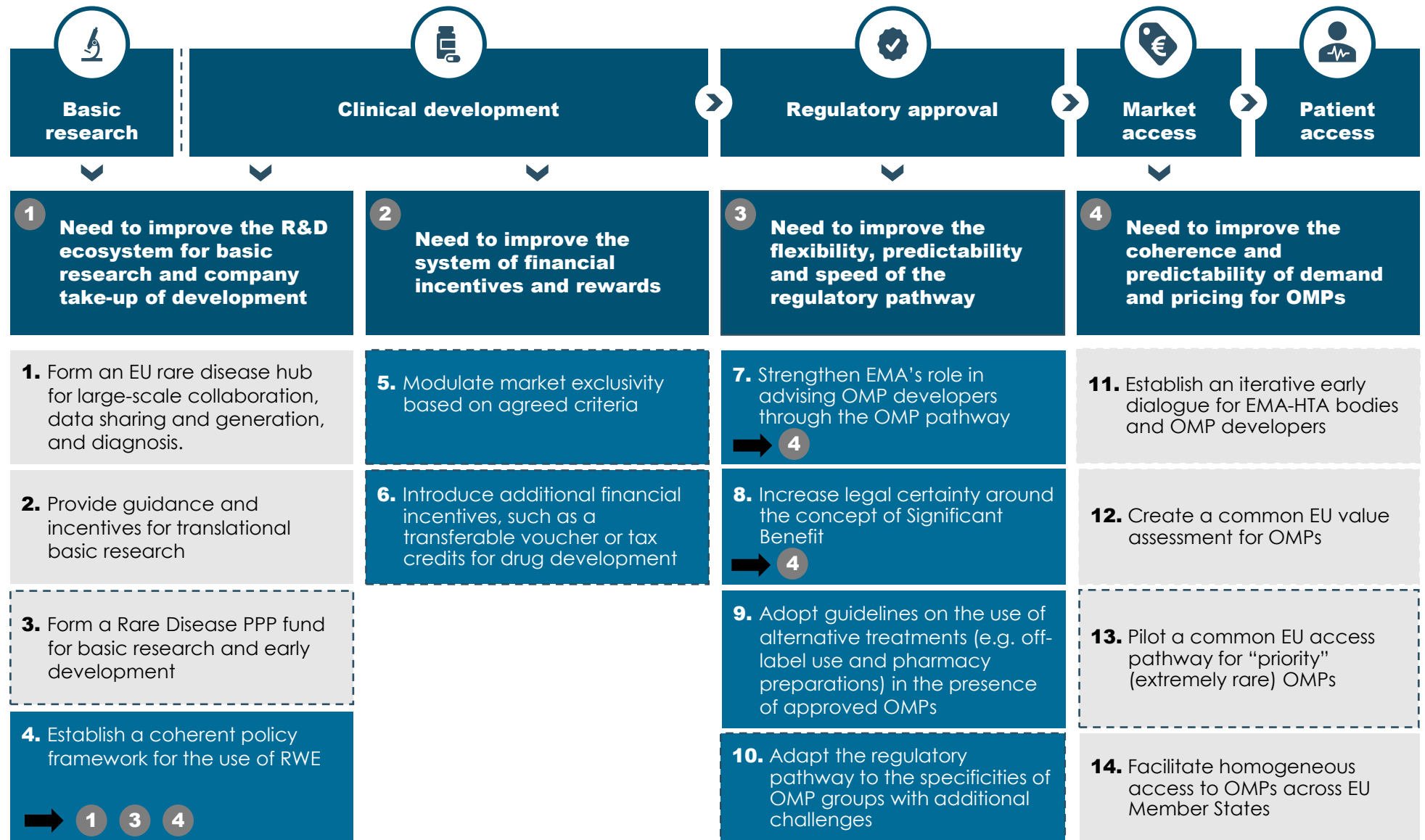
Three modulation archetypes according to the investment case, no UMN definition, proposals within OMP Reg scope

3

Develop proposals for an EU HTA Regulation adapted to OMPs

Concrete proposals on how to adjust the EU HTA to needs of OMPs, handle conflicts of interest, avoid duplication

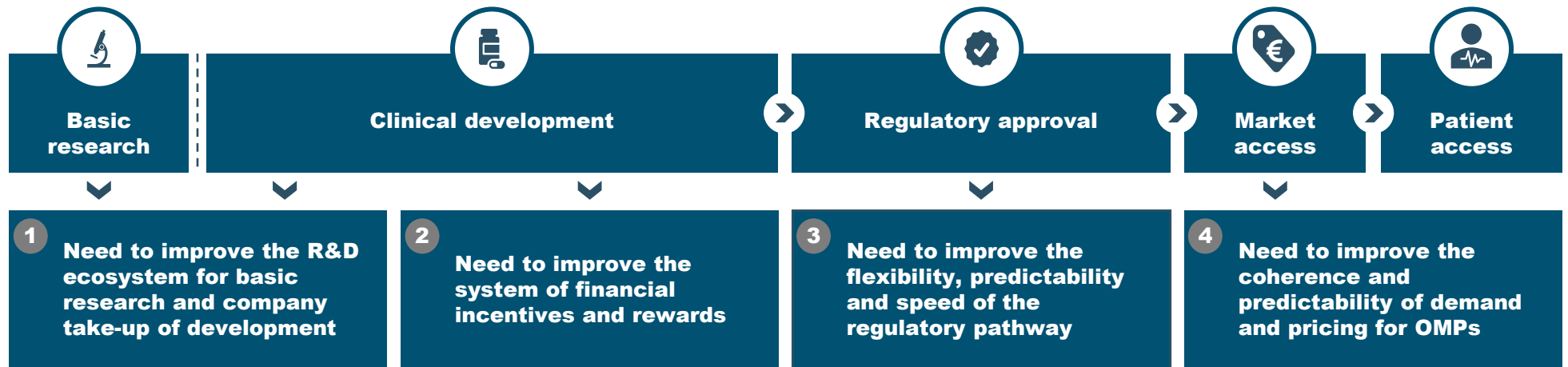
4 needs and 14 policy proposals

These proposals can be addressed through the revision of the OMP Regulation

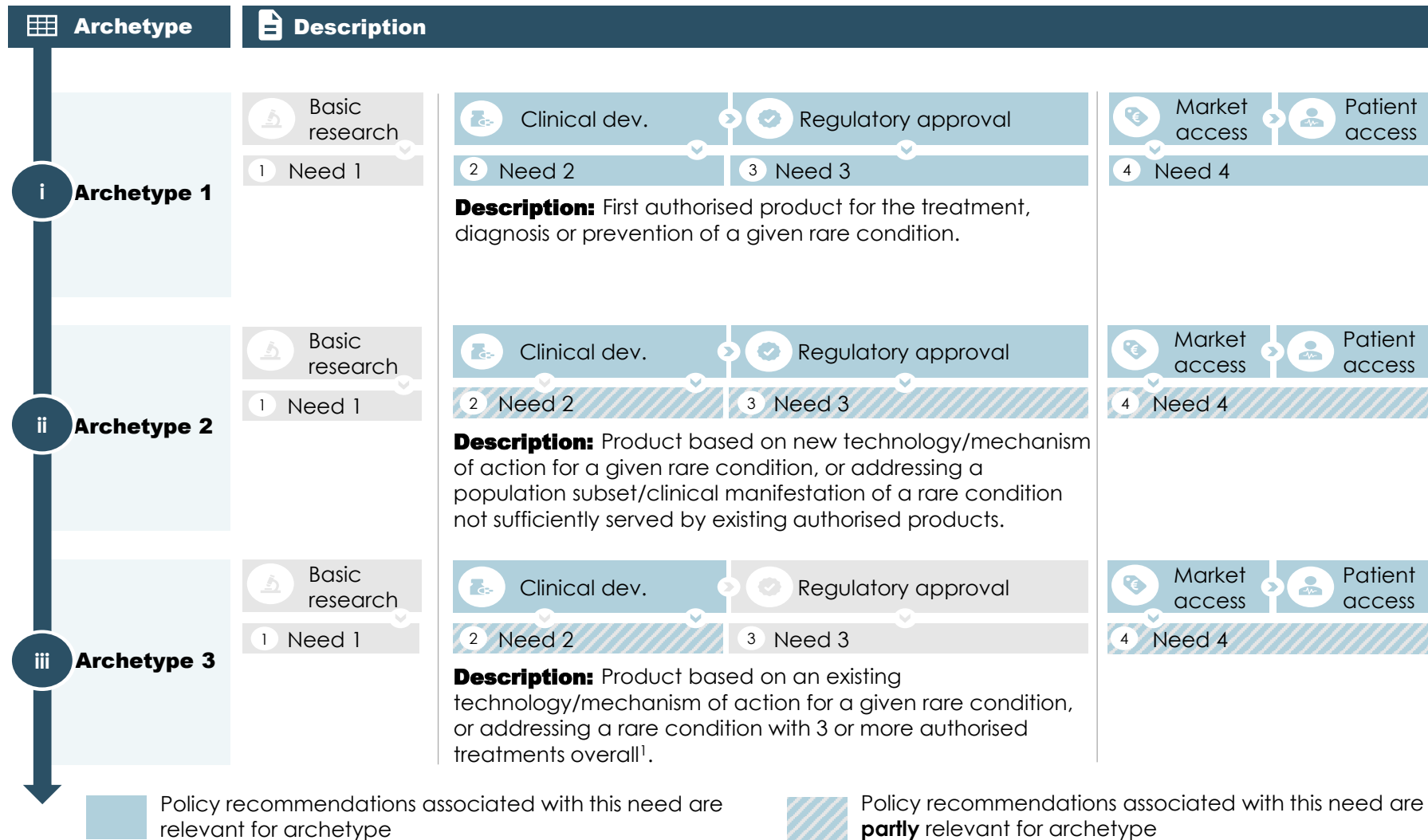

Conceive a holistic policy framework for the OMP development path

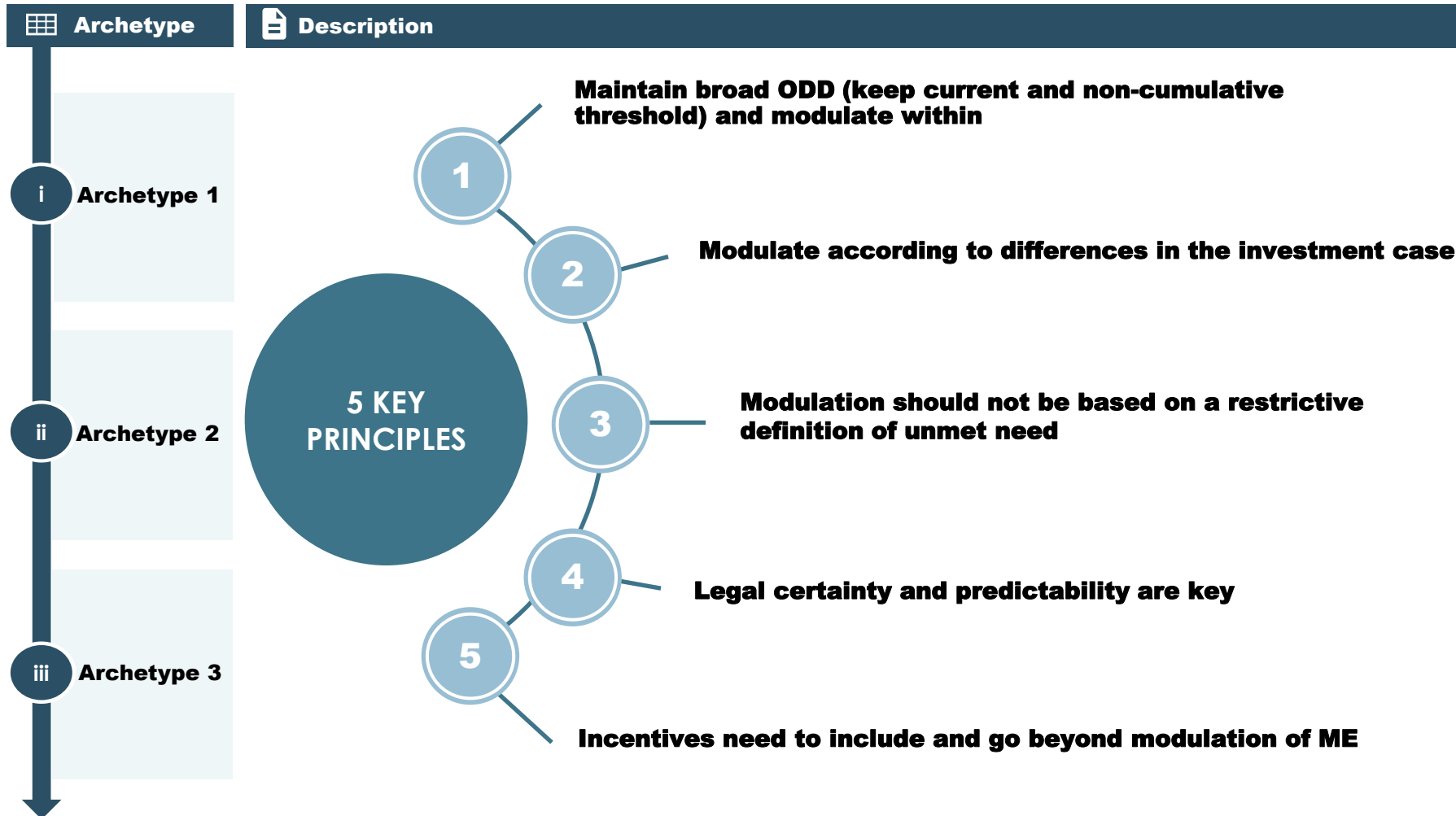
